# WHO AM I?

# WHAT UNIVERSITIES LOOK FOR

#### PASSION

Is this student so obsessed with an activity that they are already on a clear path to success? Have they won a major competition, started a club with their activity, published something, sold an app, etc.?

We want to SEE this passion at work over an extended period of time. It is not enough to simply SAY that you're passionate.

It is also no longer enough to be "well rounded." I recommend standing above the crowd in a way that makes you memorable, impressive, and undeniable.

Think about the extracurriculars on your activity list, and what they say about you!

### FIT

Why does this student need this university instead of another? And why does this university need this student?

Usually, universities ask "why us?" in a separate essay, and you should research the school, the social and academic life there, before answering.

#### LOVE FOR LEARNING

Will this student take charge of their own education? We can see that in whether or not the student has already demonstrated a love for learning. Have they gone the extra mile to follow their academic pursuits? Received top marks and excellent test scores?


One part of the application that comes into play here is the letter of recommendation... Is it from a teacher who knows the student and can speak to the student's EXTRAORDINARY drive and commitment?

## CHARACTER

Does this student have character? Are they responsible, resilient, trustworthy, etc.? Have they actually demonstrated this character in a way we can see?

Most importantly, is this student a leader?
Leadership doesn't always mean being in charge of others... It can simply mean not being a follower.

For instance, Mark Zuckerberg showed leadership by selling an app he created during high school, instead of joining the coding team like everyone else. Of course it doesn't have to be quite that extraordinary.



# **FURTHER EXPLANATION**

In the graph, we can see what matters most to admissions officers, based on the leaked documents.

"Athletics" mainly applies if you will be on a school team.

The "Personal" score is about the student's character. Think of college admissions like planning a party... Based on this student's resume, essay, letters of rec, and interview, would they be someone we want at our party?

# THE HARVARD LEAK

A recent lawsuit caused internal documents from the Harvard Admissions Office to be released. Nobody had seen these before, and it is a massive opportunity to see what admissions officers care about at Harvard and other top schools.

You can see that "Academics" are critical. But at a top school, every applicant will have excellent test scores and grades, so ensure you are taking the hardest classes available to set yourself apart.

Also realize that "Extracurricular Activities" is where you likely need to set yourself appart.





# THE TAKE-AWAY

At any top school, you pull away from the crowd by distinguishing yourself through your passion.... The activity through which you have already demonstrated success and leadership.

If you are "well rounded" and busy with too many activities, drop the ones which limit your ability to stand out. Focus on the singular story about who you are... Your brand.

At larger, or less competitive schools, it is more acceptable to be well rounded.

But wherever you're applying, academic ability is usually a prerequisite for admission.

Don't hesitate to ask me for advice! Many of my clients struggle with balancing the many aspects of the application, but it does not need to be a complicated process.

# **Get Real**

Don't share anything bad about yourself, but do show a side of yourself not many get to see. Dig deep down and find your authentic truth. It should be a little scary.







What matters to you?

What matters more than anything? It might be the passion activity on your resume. But you can also talk about your world view or a moment, person, or object that shaped your life.

# Heart of the matter

We need to care. Keep asking "so what?" about your topic until you no longer can. Until you've given us a singular reason this topic is important to you on a deeply personal level.



# Style

Re-read your favorite author. They're good for a reason. They have a voice.

If you're funny, be bold and funny.

Use figurative language, metaphor...

Rhyme if you want to. Just please proof read!





# **Avoid Pitfalls**

Avoid cliché like the plague because it's unoriginal. And remember they already have your resume, so no need to brag. This essay is more like a short story.


# Your Resume/ Activities List:
